

URP 462 Product Requirements
Department of Urban and Regional Planning

Students in URP 462 are required to produce two products to complete their senior project: 1) a document that reports their research findings in detail, and 2) a poster for presentation to a department poster session held during exam week.

The Document

The URP 462 document must be a well-organized, well-written report on the research findings. It must avoid plagiarism and provide proper citation for material that used in its preparation. Two copies of the bound document must be submitted to the Department.

The Poster

The poster specifications are 36" x 60" horizontal format. The poster will include limited text, tables, figures, images, maps and other graphic devices to communicate the research results. It should be able to be understood *without* an oral explanation by the reviewer. Detailed poster specifications are determined by the URP 462 instructor, but generally the poster should contain the following:

- Project title and advisor
- Introduction/problem definition
- Methodology
- Research Results
- Conclusions and next steps

Department funds are be available for the cost of printing the poster.
